



St. Augustine's Monastery in Krakow - being founded from XIV c. in Kazimierz district.

1996 - conservation of the set of the Baroque ogival paintings of the cloister. Self-stretching aluminium frames have been used.

1997 - conservation of the Baroque altar - confession in the Chapel of the Blessed Isaac Boner (wood conservation, reconstruction of polychromy and gilding) and the marble balustrade and the steps to the chapel.

1997 - conservation of 8 oil-paintings in the monastery.

1997 - 1998 - conservation of garden elevation and crossing over Skąlecka Street, where 1100m² of desalting plaster has been laid.

1999 - 2000 - conservation of stone benches and epitaphs on cloister walls.
