

The Building of the XIVc Infirmary for the old and the ill monks in the northern wing of the Middle Castle in Malbork.

The works done in 2005 conservation works in the interia of the Infirmary (vestibule of the Chapel, Chapel, Hall, Refectory, Chamber, Latrine) embraced plaster, bricks and stone together with painted decorations, stone and tile flooring as well as door and window carpentry with the painting decorations, metal elements and stained-glass windows.
